1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is entitled for the release of one month salary in lieu of LTC/HTC for the Block year 2022-2023, which has not been given to the petitioner by the respondents and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on

behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the legal notice dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P/9) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
