Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned order dated 22.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.4; order dated 02.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3 and order dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2. Further prayer has been made for directing the respondents not to implement impugned orders dated 22.02.2017, 02.05.2017 and 22.12.2017 till the disposal of the writ petition merely on the ground of presumption and further during the pendency of the present petition, operation of the impugned orders dated 22.02.2017, 02.05.2017 and 22.12.2017 may kindly be stayed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record the

compromise dated 08.05.2023 arrived at between the parties wherein both

the parties have agreed to get the petition disposed of in view of the compromise, which is taken on record as mark “A”.

Learned counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 has affirmed the same and has submitted that the present petition be disposed of in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Resultantly, the present petition stands disposed of in view of the compromise dated 08.05.2023 arrived at between the parties. Both the sides would be bound by terms and conditions of the compromise arrived at between the parties.
