Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation on the representations dated 29.09.2023, moved by the petitioner, i.e. Annexures P-4 and P-5.

It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in case FIRs (Annexures P-1 and P-2), at the behest of respondents No. 4 and 5, due to some political vendetta and the petitioner apprehends that they will interfere in the fair investigation of the matter. Details of the FIRs are as mentioned below: -

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has moved representations dated 29.09.2023, i.e. Annexures P-4 and P-5, to respondents No. 2 and 3 for conducting fair investigation in the matter, and for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider and dispose of the representations dated 29.09.2023, Annexure P-4 and P-5, respectively, in an expeditious manner in accordance with the law.
4. Notice of motion.
5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.
6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No. 2 and 3, i.e. the Director General of Police, Haryana and Superintendent of Police, Jind, Haryana, to consider the averments made in the representations dated 29.09.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
8. Disposed of.
