RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

 This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 14.08.2019 passed in CWP-8965-2016, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

 A perusal of the paper book shows that the ultimate order passed in the dispute between the parties is the order dated 07.10.2023; which shows that the Writ Court had not found anything to clarify qua the order dated 14.08.2019 with reference to the action of the respondents. It was further clarified in the matter that since the petitioner happens to be the widow of the son of the deceased-employee and the respondents have claimed that she is not eligible under the State Government Policy, therefore, the petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the action of the respondents, in accordance with law.

From the above, it is clear that there is no case for initiating contempt proceedings in the matter.

Dismissed.

The petitioner may approach the appropriate Court through the appropriate remedy, qua her grievance, if any.
