1. Petitioner incarcerated in the captioned FIR has come before this Court under Section 439, Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail.
2. State counsel submits that petitioner concealed the material facts from this Court. Despite criminal antecedents, he mentioned in para 9(iv) that the petitioner is not named in any FIR.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has concealed the criminal antecedents. On the last occasion also, when the petitioner had filed petition for bail, he had tried to mislead the Court and State Government had specifically taken criminal antecedents of the petitioner as a ground and further this Court while dismissing the said bail petition on 15.05.2023, had made a specific note in para 8 of the order *qua* this aspect.
4. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after mentioning all the criminal antecedents of the petitioner.
5. Given above, present petition is disposed of, having been withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
