1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 10.05.2023 passed in CWP-10089-2023.
2. Counsel for the State has produced copy of the order dated 06.09.2023 to show that pursuant to the order dated 10.05.2023, the respondent has now decided the legal notice and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
