1. Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

2. Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 23.11.2023, in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar.

3. Heard. Record perused.

4. Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

6. The petitioners have placed on record the copy of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 & P-2) as proof of their age.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that at present Marriage Certificate is not available with the petitioners though the photographs have been placed on record as Annexure P-4.

8. This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
