By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought issuance of direction to respondents to ensure protection of life and liberty besides avoidance of any kind of humiliation by the shopkeepers of Grain Market, Sector 26, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh on instructions from HC Rakesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has already made statement before respondent No.3-SHO, Sector 26, Chandigarh, to the effect that he does not want to pursue his complaint made against respondents No.5 and 6, even besides, any of the shopkeepers of the Grain Market, Sector 26, Chandigarh, since he is not having any kind of threat perception as of now. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to rebut the same

In view thereof, nothing substantial survives to be adjudicated

upon in the present petition, at this stage, as such, the same is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach the official respondents, in case of any further threat perception.
