Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking quashing of impugned order dated 20.11.2012 (Annexure P-4) passed by Ld. JMIC, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender in case FIR No.149 dated 13.08.2009 under Section 406/420 IPC, 1860 and Section 23 of the Emigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Tanda, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 16.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Ld. Trial Court and has been released on interim bail. He further submits that costs of Rs.20,000/- has also been deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Hoshiarpur on 26.12.2019 and therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infurcutous.
