1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of transfer order 23.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.6 whereby he has been transferred from Chandigarh to Unchahar (Uttar Pradesh).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, asserts that he does not press his prayer qua setting aside of impugned transfer order, however, he prays that he may be granted leave till 15.12.2023 as he is going to solemnize marriage on 08.12.2023. He has filed representation dated 24.11.2023 in this regard.

3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner has already been relieved on 23.11.2023 and he is supposed to report at new place of posting by 03.12.2023. Nevertheless, leave of the petitioner would be extended till 15.12.2023.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
