1. In compliance of the last order i.e. 04.12.2023, passed by this Court, status report by way of affidavit dated 13.12.2023, of Sh. Sucha Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, PBI/NDPS-cum-Narcotics, District Amritsar Rural, has been filed on behalf of respondent-State. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the opposite counsel.

2. The affidavit (supra), reveals that respondent No.7-Dilbagh Singh, father of petitioner No.1-Komalpreet Kaur is in jail and respondent No.8-Gurpreet Singh-brother of petitioner No.1-Komalpreet Kaur, has gone abroad (Dubai). The petitioners did not produce any evidence before the Inquiry Officer, enabling the latter to ascertain with the threat perception, if any. The Inquiry Officer has also gone to the house of the petitioners, which was found to be locked. There is no evidence or instance given on record, which can be construed, that the petitioners have any apprehension to their life and liberty. Therefore, the instant petition is

premature, however, in case the petitioners have any real apprehension to their life and liberty, they can still approach this Court by making appropriate motion at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
