The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant compensation to the petitioner, who is a survivor of burn injuries to the extent of 40% to 45%.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is no longer in contact with her counsel and he has no further instructions in the matter.
