VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue his studies in Government Model Senior Secondary School, Sector 56, Chandigarh.

On 27.02.2020, coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“A written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record. According to this reply, the petitioner is no longer studying in the school and thus, the petition has been rendered infructuous.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 07.07.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner has been forced to leave the school on account of verbal orders passed by the DEO. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to institute appropriate proceedings for claiming damages and other reliefs, in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of this case and in case any such proceedings are initiated, it would be open to the petitioner and the respondents to raise all the pleas as are available to them, in accordance with law and the Court /authority concerned would decide the same in accordance with law.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
