1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.6 to 10 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted representations dated 24.11.2023 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-3) and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, Ropar (Annexure P-4) and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into their representations dated 24.11.2023 (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only, at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Mohinder Singh Joshi, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the petitioners, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, Ropar and respondent No.3- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur are directed to depute a senior officer to look into the representations dated 24.11.2023 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and after seeking a report, they may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

7. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
