1. By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.670 dated 15.11.2022 registered under Sections 379-A and 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner along with his accomplice Abhishek was implicated for having snatched mobile phone of the complainant.

3. The prayer made on behalf of the petitioner has been opposed by learned State counsel while submitting that such kind of offences are increasing day by day in the society and the custody of the petitioner is too short as that of 03 months and 18 days only.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the paper book. I find substance in the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In the present case, the investigation has already been concluded with filing of challan and co-accused namely Abhishek has already been granted concession of regular bail by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Hisar. Moreover, the petitioner volunteers to compensate the complainant as an interim measure for a sum of Rs.20,000/-.

6. Considering the fact that the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of more than 03 months and he is not involved in any other case, I do not find any justification to extend the incarceration of the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate and deposit of Rs.20,000/- with the Trial Court at the time of his release, which shall be released in favour of the complainant upon due verification.
