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**DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)**

By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made to quash impugned order dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-11) passed by learned Additional Session Judge, Ludhiana in a case arising out of FIR No.163 dated 22.07.2018 registered at Police Station Samrala, District Khanna, Ludhiana under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, whereby bail of the petitioner was cancelled and warrants of arrest has been directed to be issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner absented himself from trial on 09.03.2023 due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were directed to be issued against him. It is contended that due to noting of the wrong date, petitioner could not appear before the Court concerned and later on, no warrant of arrest was ever executed upon him. Learned counsel also contends that petitioner is now ready to surrender within reasonable time and he be provided necessary protection.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randeep Singh Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.

This petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court concerned on or before 12.12.2023. On his such appearance, the Trial Court will be at liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and after disposal thereof, shall admit the petitioner to bail.

It is made clear that till the disposal of proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having being issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
