1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the charge-sheet dated 16.08.2017 issued by the respondent No.2 with a further prayer to release the withheld amount of retiral benefits and arrears of pension and other reitral benefits.
2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents informs the Court that a cheque bearing No.099556 dated 07.12.2022 of Rs.9,24,572/- has been released in favour of the petitioner, therefore, she prays that present petition may be disposed of having become infructuous.
