1. In the present petition, petitioners are claiming that they are entitled for the grant of benefit of regularization in service from 16.07.2008 i.e. when the employees junior to the petitioners were regularized.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the reply filed by the respondents wherein, the respondents themselves mentioned that the services of the petitioners have already been regularized from the date of their initial appointment i.e. 14.08.2008, no further grievance on said issue survives but he has no knowledge as to whether the benefit of fixation of pay from the said date has been extended to the petitioners or not hence, the petitioners be granted liberty to approach the respondents in case, the benefit of regular pay scale has not been given to the

petitioners from the date of their regularization in service, by way of filing an appropriate representation.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation, claiming the said benefit, is received from the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate representation in case any of the grievance of the petitioners still survives.

5. Ordered accordingly.
