VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.1 to 3 to send the record of the petitioners regarding completion of apprenticeship to respondents no.4 and 5.

2. An affidavit dated 08.08.2023 on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 has been filed, which is taken on record. A copy of the same has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that record has been sent and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous but the petitioners be granted liberty to institute a civil suit for claiming damages as

delay in sending record has caused loss to the petitioners.

4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Needless to mention that it is open to the petitioners to institute any proceedings, in accordance with law, including filing of civil suit for claiming damages and in the same, it would be open to the respondents to take all the pleas as are available to them, in law.
