1. On 02.12.2023, following order was passed:-

*“Prayer is for quashing of the order dated 11.10.2023,
whereby bail of the petitioner has been ordered to be cancelled
and bail bonds and surety bonds stand forfeited to the State.*

*Counsel for the petitioner submits that the absence of
the petitioner was on account of miscommunication between
the petitioner appearing before the trial Court and he noted
wrong date. Counsel further submits that the petitioner
undertakes to appear before the trial Court without fault in
future.*

*Keeping in view the undertaking tendered on behalf of
the petitioner, the petitioner is granted liberty to appear before
the trial Court on or before **08.12.2023**.*

*Notice of motion, returnable for **20.12.2023**.*

*Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on
behalf of the respondent-State.*

In the meantime, operation of the impugned order dated 11.10.2023 (P-8) shall remain stayed.”

2. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced on record order of the Learned District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad to demonstrate that the petitioner in compliance of order dated 02.12.2023, has appeared before the trial Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the absence of the petitioner was just on account of miscommunication and he noted wrong date and submits that the petitioner undertakes to regularly appear before the trial Court.

3. In view of the above, order dated 02.12.2023 is made absolute.

4. In view thereof, this petition stands disposed off.
