1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioners for directing the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioners equivalent to their juniors along with all the consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are getting less salary than their juniors, which is not permissible as the senior employee has to get more or same salary as being given to the junior employee.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 01.11.2023 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the representation dated 01.11.2023 (Annexure P/5) has been received from the petitioners and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
