1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to decide his representation dated 22.10.2023 (Annexure P-5).
2. The petitioner submits that with respect to his pensionary benefits, he has filed representation dated 22.10.2023 (Annexure P-5), however, respondents have not paid heed to the said representation. The grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed, if respondents are directed to decide his representation dated 22.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.
3. Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kang, AAG Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, assures the Court that competent authority would decide representation of the petitioner within three months from today.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
