In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though the enquiry report has already been submitted in the year 2018 in regards to the disciplinary proceedings, which are initiated against him, but for the last five years the matter is kept pending, which action of the respondent-department is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per the instructions received from the department, appropriate order on the disciplinary proceedings will be passed within a period of two months from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the passing of the

order on the disciplinary proceedings any benefit accrues to the petitioner qua release of any service benefit, which has been withheld, the same will also be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks, in case there is no impediment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case any order causing prejudice to the petitioner is passed, petitioner can avail appropriate remedy as provided under law.
