HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are entitled for the benefit as being extended to the similarly situated employees for the regularization of the services of the conductors/drivers working in the Haryana Transport Department from the date of their initial appointment keeping in view the instructions which were issued by the Department dated 28.11.2016.

2. Learned counsel submits that this Court has already granted the benefit to the similarly situated employees while passing order in CWP-12858-2018 decided on 24.08.2023 titled ***Chand Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***, hence the petitioners are entitled for the same benefit.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners have already

approached the respondents by filing a representation dated 22.10.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-11 and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, their claim is considered in view of the judgment of this Court in ***Chand Singh (supra)*** and a speaking order is passed on the representation.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case the representation, Annexure P-11, has been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks and in case, after the passing of the order, the relief is to be given to the petitioners, the same will be extended to them within a further period of 4 weeks.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
