The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to conduct proper investigation qua the mysterious death of Nikko Rani (daughter of the petitioner) and Sunil (son-in-law of the petitioner).

Learned State counsel draws the attention of this Court towards para No.2 of reply filed by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Meham, the relevant extract whereof read as under:

*“2. .... In case FIR No.20 dated 26.01.2017, u/S 302 IPC, P.S.Lakhan Majra, on the basis of instructions of higher officials, the case was re-investigated, but no accused has been traced out in the matter. Hence, the untrace report was prepared on 15.11.2018 and same was presented in the Court of Sh. Vivek Sharma, Ld.*

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*J.M.I.C,Meham, on 26.12.2018. The statement of complainant Sanjay was recorded in which he has stated that he is fully satisfied with the investigation. Thereafter, vide order dated 10.12.2018, the untrace report has been allowed by the Court of Sh. Vivek Sharma, Ld. J.M.I.C., Meham.*

Keeping in view the fact that in the present case, untrace report has been accepted by the concerned Court, no case for interference is made out.
