1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 23.03.2023 passed in CWP-6013-2023.
2. Counsel for the State has produced copy of the order dated 15.12.2023, to show that pursuant to the order dated 23.03.2023, necessary order has been passed and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, then he would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
