The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to investigate the matter and take necessary legal action against the private respondents No.4 & 5 under Sections 279/307/326/506 of IPC and other relevant Sections of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner has already approached the concerned quarters by filing complaint/representation dated 07.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) with regard to the commission of a cognizable offence in which the petitioner suffered multiple fractures.

Learned counsel further submits that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 07.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.
