Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for allotment of property in pursuance to the Punjab Management and Transfer of Municipal Properties Act, 2020 dated 01.04.2020 (Annexure P-9) and also for quashing the order dated 18.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) supplied on 16.05.2022. Further prayer has been made for staying the dispossession as well as for further alienating the suit property/changing the property in any manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that the petitioner is the occupier of the property since from last about 30 years. He has submitted that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 04.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) before the respondents but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He submits that the petitioner be granted liberty to

file fresh representation before respondent No.3 i.e. the Executive Officer, Municipal Committee, Nabha, Patiala and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She has stated that in case representation as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner is filed, then respondent No.3 will decide the same as per law.

Heard.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction that in case a representation is filed by the petitioner before respondent No.3 as submitted above within a period of two weeks from today then respondent No.3 i.e. the Executive Officer, Municipal Committee, Nabha, Patiala is directed to decide the same in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of its filing.
