1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents to investigate the case arising out FIR No. 0026 dated 23.03.2018 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Rampura District Bathinda.

2. Pursuant to the notice, a status report has been filed by way of affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Learned State counsel submits that the SSP had constituted teams of the police officials with a specific direction to arrest the accused by adopting all methods including technical methods. He further contends that during the investigation, it has been found that the accused is presently confined in Central Jail, Hisar in case arising out of FIR No. 582 dated 26.11.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 466 and 471 IPC, Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana. He further submits that the SSP has

also directed the SHO, Police Station City Rampura to complete the investigation after the arrest of accused Surjit Singh and to file the challan in the competent Court in a time bound manner.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
4. Needless to say that the police is expected to carry out the investigation in the present case expeditiously and impartially.
