N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also direct to respondents No.4 to 10 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka and the petitioners shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation (Annexure P-3).
3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Mohinder Singh Joshi, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the representation (Annexure P3) and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

7. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
