HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though he has been promoted to the post of Election Kanungo but he has been posted at Faridabad whereas, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner himself is not medically fit and has to take care of his old aged father, who is now at Rewari, the present order of promotion-cum-transfer will amount to mid term transfer as well.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that there is already a post of Election Kanungo at Rewari, which is lying vacant and the petitioner could be easily accommodated on the same, hence, the respondents are under an obligation to consider the said request of the petitioner so as to post him near Rewari so that he can take care of his old aged father and there is no administrative exigency as well.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the said request, the petitioner has filed a representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-6) with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-6) is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided within a period of four weeks of the receipt of copy of this order by taking a sympathetic view and in case possible, all the efforts be made to adjust the petitioner at either Rewari or near to Rewari.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
