1. Learned counsel for the respondents in all fairness has stated that he has no objection if the application containing objections filed on behalf of Randeep son of Ravinder is ordered to be disposed of in a time bound manner and in that eventuality, the warrants of sale may kept in abeyance till then.
2. Under the circumstances, the revision petition is disposed of directing the Executing Court to consider and decide the application containing third party objections filed by Randeep son of Ravinder as per law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order there. Till then, the sale warrants issued by the Court be kept in abeyance. Parties through counsel are directed to appear before the Executing Court on 18.07.2023.
3. However, nothing mentioned in this order shall be taken as any opinion on the final merits of the case.
