SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has *inter alia* sought direction to official respondents to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

2. Noticing the nature of allegations made in the petition, this Court is not inclined to exercise its jurisdiction under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition. Still further, he submits that as the dispute is primarily matrimonial, parties may be referred to Mediation Centre of this Court.

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4. Permission to withdraw the present petition is granted and his request for referring the matter to the Mediation Centre of this Court is accepted.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. The matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Parties are directed to appear there on 08.01.2024. Report of learned Mediator be brought on the record in due course.
