This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to initiate proceedings under Section 51(3) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act against respondent No.4 who has embezzled the amount of the Gram Panchayat and further to take legal action against him as per the inquiry report dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 08.08.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Learned State counsel has submitted that as per the short reply submitted by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Madlauda, District Panipat, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, it has

been specifically stated that the inquiry regarding the allegations made in the complaint made by the petitioner has already been taken up and the petitioner was also given an opportunity of hearing on 12.09.2017 during the inquiry as conducted by the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Panipat and thereafter, has submitted the inquiry report and respondent No.2 being satisfied with the report of Additional Deputy Commissioner, Panipat, has disposed of the complaint (Annexure P-1) and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. It is further submitted that even the tenure of respondent No.4 has lapsed and thus, on the said account also, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above-said facts, has submitted that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
