1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to register/enroll with Punjab State Pharmacy Council, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the portal is not allowing the petitioner to file an application for the registration with the Punjab State Pharmacy Council, Punjab keeping in view the fact that the qualification needs to be mentioned even while applying for the registration.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once the petitioner has already been granted the required diploma and he has already completed the training, there cannot be any objection for registration of the

petitioner with the Punjab State Pharmacy Council.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 16.10.2023 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.6 and respondent No.6 be directed to pass appropriate order on the said representation in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any further prejudice.

6. Mr. Rohit Ahuja, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 and Mr. Ranjit Singh Kalra, Advocate, who is also present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6.

7. Learned counsel for respondent No.6 submits that appropriate order on the representation dated 16.10.2023 (Annexure P-6) will be passed by respondent No.6 within a period of four weeks from today and the same will be informed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for respondent No.6, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
