N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against the accused in case FIR No.191 dated 19.09.2023 registered under Sections 447/120-B IPC at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural. A further prayer has been made for adding the offences under Sections 379/420/506 IPC.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but her grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 20.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look

into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural-respondent No.2 to depute a senior officer to look into the representation dated 20.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
