1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he had claimed the benefit of compassionate appointment, which benefit was declined by the respondents by passing a totally cryptic and non-speaking order dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat, submits that the order dated 03.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) may kindly be treated to have been withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order by giving detailed reasons as to whether or not, in the facts and circumstances the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of compassionate appointment and fresh order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned

counsel submits that all the necessary instructions issued by the Government of Haryana including the letter dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-8) will be taken into account while passing the order.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
