JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The prayer in the present Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members as the conduct of the official respondents No.3 and 4 seems to be negligent.

2. The learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Jatinder Singh submits that both the applications submitted by the petitioner have already been enquired into and have been found to be incorrect. He further submits that the earlier application has already been filed whereas the latter one has been sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned as the same has to be filed too.

3. In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in this case. The same stands dismissed.
