Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking quashing of order dated 16.03.2019 (Annexure P-2), passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, declaring the petitioner as a proclaimed person in case FIR No.513 dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure P-1), under Section 306 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Baljit Singh, submits that the present petition has become infructuous inasmuch as the petitioner stands arrested on 03.03.2022 in FIR (Annexure P-1).

On the last date of hearing, i.e. 18.11.2022, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner, whereupon registry was directed

to notify learned counsel for the petitioner of the next date of hearing (31.01.2023), however today as well, no one has appeared to represent the petitioner despite the learned counsel being notified of the date fixed.
