By filing the instant revision-petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners-plaintiffs (here-in-after to be referred as 'the plaintiffs') have sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Moga (for short 'the trial Court'), to decide ***Civil Suit No.252 of 2020*** titled as "***Suresh Thapar and anr. vs. Sudha Thapar etc.***" in a time bound manner, while averring that they are old persons and they had filed the above-said Civil Suit in March, 2020 and the same has not yet been decided.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners-plaintiffs in the present revision-petition, at the preliminary stage and have also perused the file carefully.

3. Keeping in view the facts that the plaintiffs are senior citizens, aged about 71 and 77 years respectively and the afore-mentioned Civil Suit

is pending adjudication for the last about 3¾ years and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the said Civil Suit, the revision petition in hand is, hereby, disposed of with a direction to the concerned trial Court to conclude the trial proceedings and decide the afore-referred Civil Suit, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
