PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.39 dated 13.04.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that not only he relies upon the orders, whereby co-accused Samandeep Singh @ Raja @ Sanamdeep Singh has been granted regular bail, but also it is a matter of record that FIR qua some of the accused already stands quashed on the basis of compromise and vide order dated 20.11.2023 passed in **CRM-M-52059-2023**, this Court has already taken cognizance of the compromise and the complainant who was represented by counsel has already admitted the fact of there being compromise between the

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parties. Counsel further submits that as per the order passed by this Court, the petitioner is required to appear before the concerned Magistrate on 21.12.2023 to depose with respect to compromise.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

4. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
