1. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to conduct fair and proper investigation on the representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioner.

2. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that aggrieved by the acts and conduct of respondents No. 5 to 10, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure -5). But no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. He further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to consider and

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dispose of the representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

6. Mr. Arshdeep Singh Brar, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of respondents No. 5 to 10 and filed his vakalatnama. The same is taken on record. He submits that respondents No. 5 to 10 be also given opportunity to appear and plead their version before respondent No. 3, while disposing of the representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-3), to which learned counsel for the petitioner pleads no objection.

7. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law after giving an opportunity of being heard to respondents No. 5 to 10.
