SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. This is the fourth petition filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.264 dated 17.12.2019, registered for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-3, including challan report dated 10.10.2020 under Section 173, Cr.P.C., Annexure P-4, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Previous petition (CRM-M-47888-2023) at the hands of the same petitioners came up for hearing before this Court on 22.09.2023 and the following order was passed in the main case:-

“1. This is the second petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.264 dated 17.12.2019, registered for offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. *After addressing for some time, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to take all the available pleas at the appropriate stage.*
3. *Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.”*

3. Concededly, there is no change in the circumstances. Proceedings are fixed before the Trial Court for consideration on framing of charge on 16.12.2023.

4. By way of instant petition, petitioners are attempting to re-agitate the matter, which cannot be permitted. In fact, such a petition deserves to be dismissed with cost.

5. Petition is dismissed. Cost of Rs.10,000/- is imposed on each of the petitioners, which will be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Cell, PGIMER, Sector-12, Chandigarh. Copy of the order be sent to the Trial Court to ensure the compliance of the order.
