1. This is the petitioner's fourth attempt to get the bail during the pendency of the trial arising from FIR No.115, dated 15.10.2017, registered under Section 15/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

2. Sh. Vikas Arora, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab states that the entire prosecution's evidence has been recorded and now the case is fixed for final arguments. The learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Kanwar Raj Kumar, submits that the hearing of the case is being adjourned on the request of the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it would not be appropriate to grant bail to the petitioner. However, the Special Judge is requested to conclude the hearing of the case positively within a period of two months, from today and inform this Court.

4. With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
