VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue the detail mark sheet of the petitioner of Bachelor of Science (Hons.) (Mathematics) of 6th semester held in May, 2023. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.4 to issue the roll number to the petitioner and allow her to appear in the 1st semester examination of M.Sc. (Mathematic).

2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 has brought to the notice of this Court proceedings of the meeting of the Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor in which the petitioner and her father were also

present and the answer books were also shown to her and in view of the seriousness of the answer book tampering case, the Committee had concluded that the case of the petitioner along with another student be referred to the Police/appropriate Investigating Agency for investigation and to take strict action against the petitioner and one more student and also the dealing staff. The said documents are taken on record and marked as Mark "A". Relevant portion of the same is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“Proceedings of the Meeting

A meeting of the Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in continuation of meeting dated 21.08.2023, 23.08.2023 & 28.08.2023 to examine the matter of A/books of B.Sc (Hons.) Mathematics QPID (61252 & 61254) 6th semester examination held in May 2023 was held in the office of Controller of examination on 31.08.2023 at 11.00 A.M. The following members were present in the meeting:

The Committee recorded the statement of concerned Students (total 03) and decided as follows:

1. In meeting one student (Jyoti Kumari) and her father were present in the meeting, the committee members have briefed/discussed the case with her father and answer book was also shown to him. Her father didn't explain the things well, even after discussing with her daughter.

2. One student (Monika) and her father were not attended the meeting.

In view of the seriousness of the answer book tempering

case, the committee concluded that the case may be referred to police/appropriate investigating agency for investigation and request to take strict action against the two students and concerned dealing staff who are involved in the cases and the process of Re-evaluation of above three answer books (FR No.612522300130, 612522300132 & 612542300052) may be hold till the final decision.
