1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the complaint dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) made by the petitioner to respondent No.2 on the basis of which cognizable offence under the Indian Penal Code is made out against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is Ex-Subedar retired from Army and against the private respondents mentioned in the complaint, he has approached the concerned quarter number of times by way of complaint dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) but no action has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the complaint dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. IPS Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Let a copy of complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.
6. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the counsel appearing for the petitioner and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed with a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to consider and decide the complaint dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 09.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
