1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11, 12 , 14 and 15 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 26.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed in Case No.HMA-418-2021.
2. The order, qua which the contempt is alleged, is only talking about the visitation rights or the adjustments qua meeting of the father with the child. The implementation of the order would involve so much facts and circumstances, involving disputed questions of fact, which is not even possible for this Court to decipher the same, by any means. Therefore, it would not be appropriate to initiate the proceedings for contempt of courts.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise his grievance before the Court which has passed the order or before the Executing Court, if any.
