MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.3 & 4, not to harass and threaten the petitioner, at the hands of respondent No.5.

2. Contends that petitioner has filed suit for permanent injunction against respondent No.5, which is pending for adjudication before learned Additional Civil Judge, Bhudlada. Further contends that respondent No.5, instead of receiving summons and appearing before learned trial Court, is filing false and frivolous representations before the Police authorities in order to harass the petitioner.

3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the paper-book.

4. Concededly, civil suit is already pending between the parties, i.e. petitioner as well as respondent No.5. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition and/or issue any mandate to the authorities concerned, at this stage.

5. In view of the above, there is no option, but to dispose off the petition.

6. Ordered accordingly.
7. Needless to say that petitioner shall be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law, if an occasion so arises.
8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
