1. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that due to typographical error, Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab, has been mentioned as respondent No. 2, however, the same has to be Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab and the directions may be issued accordingly.

2. In view of oral submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it is ordered that in the memo of parties, respondent No. 2 be read as Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab.

3. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to the official respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No. 4 to 6.

4. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure -5)

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to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab, to consider and dispose of the complaint/representation dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. AG, Punjab. who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab, to consider the averments made in the complaint/representation dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure P-5) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.

7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.

8. Disposed of.
