The petitioner, by way of present revision petition, seeks quashing of order dated 09.11.2023 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Moga, whereby protection of life and liberty has been granted to respondent Nos. 2 & 3.

[2] It is averred that marriage of petitioner and respondent No. 2- Gurwinder Kaur was solemnized in the year 2009 and out of this wedlock, three girl child were born. Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 (Gurwinder Kaur & Navjeet Singh, respectively) are stated to be in a “Live-in Relationship” and filed a petition seeking protection of their life and liberty before learned Sessions Judge, Moga, wherein, vide the impugned order, protection was granted to them.

Hence, the present revision petition.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be

satisfied in case a direction is issued to Senior Superintendent of Police Moga, to look into the matter and pass a speaking order thereon expeditiously, while treating the present petition as representation on behalf of petitioner.

[4] The above prayer seems to be reasonable and justified.

[5] Notice of motion to respondent No. 1 only at this stage.

[6] Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

[7] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the grievance of petitioner by treating the present petition as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
